# Website Terms and Conditions of Use Policy

## I. Purpose

This Policy governs the use of the Albert Einstein College of Medicine (“Einstein” or “we” or “us”) network of websites (collectively referred to as the “Site”).

## II. Scope

This Policy applies to anyone who uses Einstein and Einstein-related websites and webpages.

## III. Policy

Please read these Terms and Conditions carefully. Your use of the Site (as defined below) constitutes your agreement to these Terms and Conditions.

The following terms and conditions (the “Terms and Conditions”) govern your use of this website (together with any successor site(s) and all Services (as defined below), the “Site”). Your use of the Site is governed by these Terms and Conditions regardless of how you access the Site (including through the Internet, through Wireless Access Protocol (commonly referred to as “WAP”), through a mobile network, or otherwise). The Site is operated and made available by Einstein. We provide Site users with access to content and services related to us and our academic programs, faculty and students, including video, audio, images, forums, text, data and other similar content (such content and services, collectively, the “Services”). These Terms and Conditions constitute an agreement between you and us.

### III.A. Acceptance of Terms

By using the Site, you agree to these Terms and Conditions and to any additional rules and guidelines that we post on the Site. We may make changes to these Terms and Conditions from time to time; we may notify you of such changes by any reasonable means, including by posting the revised version of these Terms and Conditions on the Site. Your use of the Site following changes to these Terms and Conditions will constitute your acceptance of those changes; provided, however, any material change to these Terms and Conditions shall not apply retroactively to any claim or dispute between you and us in connection with these Terms and Conditions that arose prior to the “LAST UPDATED” date applicable to that version of these Terms and Conditions in which we included such material change. We may, at any time, modify or discontinue all or part of the Site; charge, modify or waive fees required to use the Site; or offer opportunities to some or all Site users. If you do not agree to these Terms and Conditions, you may not access or otherwise use the Site.

### III.B. Proprietary Rights

We and/or our respective licensors own all rights, title and interest in and to the Site, and all of the content (including, for example, audio, photographs, illustrations, graphics, other visuals, video, copy, software, etc.), code, data and materials thereon, the look and feel, design and organization of the Site, and the compilation of the content, code, data and materials on the Site, including, but not limited to, any copyrights, trademark rights, patent rights, database rights, moral rights, sui generis rights and other intellectual property and proprietary rights therein. ### III.C. Limited License

Subject to your compliance with these Terms and Conditions, and solely for so long as you are permitted by us to access and use the Site, you may view one (1) copy of any content on the Site to which we provide you access hereunder on any single computer solely for your personal, noncommercial home use, provided that you keep intact all copyright and other proprietary notices. Except as expressly authorized in advance by us in writing, you agree not to reproduce, modify, rent, lease, loan, sell, distribute, or create derivative works based (whether in whole or in part) on, all or any part of the Site or any materials made available through the Site.

### III.D. Rules of Conduct

You are solely responsible for the accuracy and content of information that you submit through the site. ### III.F. Registration


