Judith Wylie-Rosett has a doctoral degree in nutrition from Columbia University's Teachers College and completed a dietetic internship at New York Hospital.

Dr. Wylie-Rosett has collaborated in multicenter clinical trials and other research to address the translation of care recommendations into healthcare for people with diabetes, heart disease, cancer and obesity. Her research interests include the role of lifestyle in chronic disease prevention and control and public health policies to address health disparities. She has served as principal investigator on a number of research projects for such organizations as the National Institutes of Health; the National Institute of Diabetes and Digestive and Kidney Diseases; the National Heart, Lung and Blood Institute; and the American Heart Association.

The author of numerous books and articles in her field, Dr. Wylie-Rosett is a member of the American Diabetes Association, the American Dietetic Association, the American Heart Association, and the American Association of Diabetes Educators, and is the associate editor of the journal *Diabetes Care*.
