

## CANCER EPIDEMIOLOGY Assistant/Associate/Full Professor

Applications are invited for a full-time Assistant/Associate/Full Professor of cancer epidemiology in the Department of Epidemiology and Population Health (DEPH) at the Albert Einstein College of Medicine, a leading research institution with a strong commitment to excellence in research. The epidemiologist who occupies this position will be expected to develop an independent program of research in cancer epidemiology, focusing on one or more of the following areas: molecular epidemiology, genetic epidemiology, obesity epidemiology; to participate in the activities of Cancer Epidemiology, Prevention and Control program of the Albert Einstein Cancer Center; and to teach medical and graduate students.
