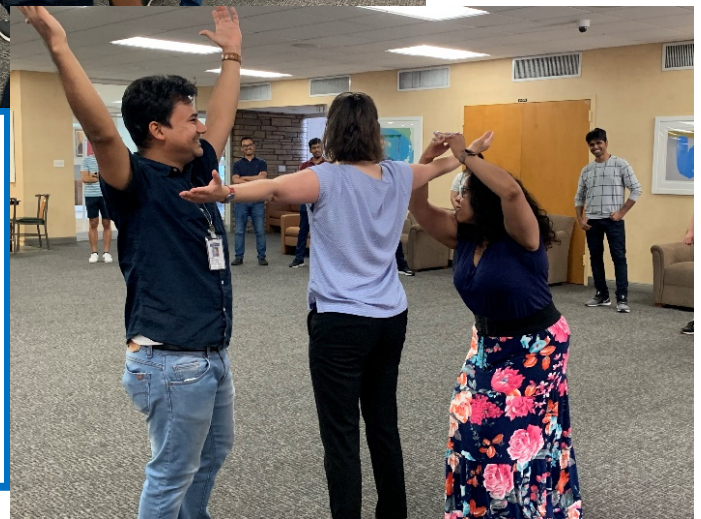

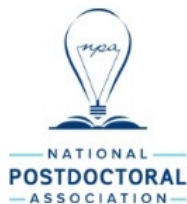
IN CASE YOU MISSED IT:

Have you ever considered a career as a **Clinical Laboratory Microbiologist**?

If you have an interest in microbiology, diagnostic assay development, teaching, and running a laboratory, than a career in clinical microbiology may be for you! Those with a PhD degree can go onto complete 2-3 year training programs that provide eligibility for becoming a board-certified medical and public health microbiologist. Career opportunities include becoming a hospital or public health laboratory director that is responsible for assuring the quality of laboratory results, development and implementation of diagnostic assays to improve patient care, publishing studies that assess the quality and impact of laboratory results, and teaching medical students, residents, and infectious disease fellows.
